

Community Phlebotomy

Coronavirus update - Changes to services from Wednesday 25 March until further notice

Coronavirus could make you, your friends or family very ill. Especially if you have a long-term condition.

Trafford Clinical Commissioning Group is working with our partners, Trafford Local Care Organisation and Manchester Foundation Trust to reduce the risk to patients, their families and to our staff members of passing the virus on further.

What does this mean for me?

When you need a blood test your GP provides you with a blood form, which you take with you to one of the clinics to have your blood taken.

From Wednesday 25 March blood test clinics will only be run from Trafford General Hospital, Partington Health Centre and Chapel Road Clinic. This decision has been taken with our providers and partners to help manage the spread of the virus, to support patient and staff safety and to reduce pressure on GP practices.

When referred to phlebotomy you will need to choose the best location for you and telephone the booking line that relates to your chosen clinic.

PLEASE NOTE: You must have a copy of your paper appointment booking form to attend clinics at Partington or Chapel Road. If you do not have a copy of the form please contact Trafford General.
